



COVID-19

DIRECTED HEALTH MEASURES(DHM)

STATEWIDE *(regardless of health district)*

Effective until May 31st

- Closure of bars, gentlemen's clubs, bottle clubs, indoor movie theaters, and indoor theaters
- Closure of all schools and extra-curricular activities
- No organized sports games or practices for youth or adults

Beginning June 1st

- Reopening of certain youth team sports with some restrictions

Beginning May 4th

- Churches
 - Allowed to open for services with some restrictions

- Elective Medical and Dental Procedures
 - Hospitals can resume elective surgeries and procedures under the following guidelines:
 - They maintain 30% general bed availability, 30% ICU bed availability, and 30% ventilator availability AND have a two-week supply of necessary PPE in their specific facility.

PUBLIC HEALTH SOLUTIONS DISTRICT *(Fillmore, Gage, Jefferson, Saline, Thayer Counties)*

Effective May 18th, 2020

- Beauty Industry (hair/nail salons, barber shops, tattoo parlors, massage therapists)
 - Allowed to open for services with restrictions
 - Employees and customers must wear face masks
 - Must follow the ten-person rule and keep 6 ft distance between customers/clients

- Restaurants
 - Allowed to open for in-room dining with restrictions
 - Limit of 50% of maximum occupancy rating at a time
 - Maximum of six individuals in each dining party with 6 ft. between parties
 - No self-serve buffets and/or salad bars
 - No bar-only patrons

- Childcare
 - Child care centers can increase the number of children per room from 10 to 15.
