VILLAGE OF DEWITT PRESS RELEASE

In response to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic emergency, the Village of DeWitt has been monitoring various governmental agencies such as the World Health Organization (WHO), Center for Disease Control (CDC), Nebraska State Government, and the Nebraska's Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS).

As of March 17, 2020, Randall Badman, Chairman of the Village Board, signed a Local Emergency Declaration regarding the COVID-19 pandemic.

Also, pursuant to the CDC updating their recommendation that any and all public gatherings be limited to ten (10) persons or less, and in the interest of public safety, effective March 17, 2020, the Village of DeWitt is cancelling all meetings and gatherings at all Village facilities including the Burkley Library, Community Center, and DeWitt Senior Center. All Village recreation programs are suspended and the use of Village ballfields and parks for games and/or practices is prohibited until further notice. The Village Office will be closed to the public but will be available via telephone: (402) 683-5025, or email: clerk@villageofdewitt.com, to continue to conduct daily business. Utility bill payments can be made online at dewitt.ne.gov (link on right hand side), by mail (P.O. Box 208, DeWitt, NE 68341), or by placing the same in the Village drop box located in front of the Village office.

The Village will continue to provide essential services such as Electric, Water, Wastewater, Fire and EMS.
